ABOUT THE SERIES

The series aims to increase understanding about racial equity and empower participants to work for change within themselves, their own organizations, and communities. We provide a forum to unlearn and relearn from each other and translate new knowledge into action.



IN EACH SESSION:

- Participants prepare with videos and/or written material from the Smithsonian African American Museum of History and Culture and other resources.
- A community leader shares their insights on the topic and launches the discussion groups.
- Discussions are led by trained facilitators to digest materials, process their implications, and generate action plans.
- Additional resources are generated by producers and participants.
- Participants are provided curriculum components to use for free with their own students, colleagues, and communities.
